Florida State University Trombone Studio:

My responsibility at Florida State consisted of teaching applied trombone and euphonium lessons as well as coaching chamber ensembles. The average semester load for applied lessons was approximately five students. I was responsible for developing an academic curriculum for these students including syllabi and appropriate supplemental materials. My duties as a chamber ensemble coaching were to assist students in the formation of high-quality ensemble techniques and prepare them for successful public performance.

Florida State University Trombone Choir:

My responsibility to the Florida State University Trombone Choir was one of leadership. As well as being the founder of the group, I was also the director. Duties to the organization included auditioning prospective performers, planning concerts, making community contacts, arranging new music for the group, and also conducting. In addition to this, I also attended to the administrative and managerial aspects of directing the trombone choir.

Private Teaching Studio:

I instruct students on tenor and bass trombone, and have also instructed euphonium and tuba students. I develop curriculum for the students, assess achievement, and prepare students for various competitions, All-State honor bands and orchestras, and collegiate auditions.

Low Brass Instructor:

I have served as an instructor of low brass for high schools in Tennessee and West Virginia. Duties for each of my appointments included instruction of students in on-the-field situations, and assisting in the teaching of drill, including marching and maneuvering. Some of my appointments have included rehearsing and refining music with the entire brass section in addition to low brass group. I have also been involved with drill writing and music arranging for several of the bands for which I have worked.
