



Lohgad, Visapur and Bhaja Caves

This region has considerable historical importance, with structures dating back over 2000 years. It is also a very scenic region. Several hikes of varying duration can be planned in this area.

Data on Lohgad, Visapur and Bhaja Caves was collected during hike of February 1-2, 2004. Map produced using the Global Positioning System (GPS). All roads, tracks and land-marks are accurate to within 15 feet (5 m). All other features are approximations.
