



Telbaila

Telbaila is an unusual rock formation located in a sparsely populated region south of Khandala. It provides an excellent climbing opportunity for experienced rock climbers. However, even non-rock-climbers will enjoy the hike to the base of the Telbaila rock wall. In addition, the drive from Khandala to Telbaila is very scenic, making it worth the effort for just about any type of visitor.

Global Positioning System (GPS) data on Telbaila was collected during hike of February 2, 2004 by Dr. Yuvaraj Chavan (Y.B.), Dr. Navin Verma, Vitthal Awari (member of YZ Trekkers) and Mahesh Chengalva.
