## Selected achievements:

- Initiated proposal for a content management system. The resulting investment in the Vignette platform created significant organizational efficiencies by allowing developers to focus on creating tools rather than marking up content and by empowering editorial staff to create and publish content on their own.
- Developed information architecture and navigation scheme for ENC's Web site. Implemented content delivery scheme that permits easy reuse of content in different contexts and allows automated migration of legacy content.
- Adapted Vignette (primarily an online content management/delivery system) to extend its capabilities to generating HTML based CD-ROMs. This speeded up development and allowed content developed for CD-ROM based delivery to be ported easily for online use and vice-versa.

- Enhanced search experience by developing curriculum resources and site searches powered by Autonomy. This involved conceiving and implementing a result weighting algorithm that significantly improved the relevance of search results to address shortcomings revealed by testing based on real-life user searches.
- Transformed process of updating information published in ENC's Guidebook of Federal Resources by creating an extranet application to allow program contacts across the country to review and update information. By replacing a labor intensive phone based update process this resulted in significant savings of staff time.
- Formulated system of "immortal" URLs designed to survive site reorganizations. Use of these in catalog records and in online documents eliminated the need for time consuming updating of links every time parts of the site are reorganized or changed.
