Anytime you are in the area, you are dearly invited to visit our new Canaan home, in the quiet northeast community of Pasadena. You will be blessed by the amazing work of God through His dedicated servants on this campus. As you may already know, this is a place where different organizations, professors, technicians and administrators work together as one body toward a common goal. The goal is to prepare equip and mobilize individuals, churches and missionaries from all over the world, with the tools and information for global evangelism.

WHY DOES GOD CALL US TO PARTNER IN HIS WORK

Our calling springs from God's act of love, demonstrated through His Son Jesus Christ. (John 3: 16). First, GOD IS A RELATIONAL FATHER. He delights in our communion with Him. God calls us to have the relationship He created us to have with Him. Secondly, GOD LOVES THE WORLD SO MUCH. He desires that no one should perish, but that all may have eternal life. He calls us to partner in the completion of his purpose for the world. Jesus says, "I am the door of the sheepfold, anyone who enters by Me shall be saved. I have other sheep that I must bring, and they shall be one fold, one shepherd". (John 10: 7, 9, 16).

WHEN DOES GOD CALL US

In good times and in tumult times, God calls us. Sometimes He calls us into situations that seem humanly impossible. *Then we realize that, it is not us, but Him who works through us to accomplish His good purpose.* In the heat of persecution of Christians in Jerusalem (*just after Stephen was stoned to death* (*Acts 7: 59-60*). Philip was called to GAZA ROAD, *to lead the Ethiopian Eunuch to Jesus*. (Acts 8: 26). In the same way, Ananias was called to meet SAUL OF TARSUS. (Acts 9: 10-11). Ananias had heard all about Saul's evil acts against Christians in Jerusalem, and the purpose of his mission to DAMASCUS. But when Ananias obeyed, he partnered in one of the most powerful life changing work of God. He played an important role in the conversion of Saul into a vessel for God's use.

Prophet Isaiah used the above verse in reference to those who brought the news of exiles' deliverance from captivity in Babylon. (Isaiah 52: 7). Apostle Paul applied the verse to the messengers of the Gospel (Romans 10:15).

As my favorite evangelism verse, it always brings to my mind, the image of those pioneer missionaries, and some present day missionaries. They travel miles on feet, (some barefooted), up and down the hills and mountains, trekking along winding, and narrow dusty paths to bring the Good News of God's love, to people living in the remote ends of the earth. How would anyone see those weary, battered and dusty feet of these missionaries as beautiful?

TEACHING THE WORD

Yes, those weary feet of the missionaries can be beautiful, but in the context of **HOW WE APPROACH** the people to whom we bring the Good News.

Ananias approached Saul, with the greeting "Brother Saul". (Acts 9: 17). To call someone who had done so much evil to his fellow Christians, "brother"; - It surely took preparation with the power of God that comes with the Gospel (Ephesians 6: 15). When Philip reached Gaza, he heard the Ethiopian Eunuch reading the Book of Isaiah. He approached him with the question, "Do you understand what you are reading". (Acts 8: 30-39). This question led the Eunuch to see in Philip "the beautiful feet of a messenger of Good News". He saw that


messenger of Good News". He saw that Philip **showed interest in him and understood his need**. He invited Philip on to his chariot. Philip used this invitation to preach the Gospel in a way the Eunuch heard, understood, believed and requested to be baptized.

It takes "PREPAREDNESS AND UNDERSTANDING to cultivate LOVE RELATIONSHIP,". And this is the pre-requisite that makes the Gospel message meaningful for a majority of people in all walks of life, culture and social status, in any part of the world. We must always be prepared to first know as much as we can about the people, understand where they are in life (their needs and interests), and use these to guide us in cultivating love relationship. GOD IS A RELATIONAL FATHER. When we respond to partner in His work, it is not just a job or a task to be accomplished. It is a mission of revealing Him to the world; in ways that people can Hear, See, and Relate to the Good News of His love. In some cultures this is value transformation, a deep rooted sensitive issue that requires an understanding approach.

The purchase of a locally manufactured "INTERMEDIATE" Palm Oil Processing Equipment, (as shown on the picture), is an investment that will have countless benefits including:
