There are three Cheyenne vowels (a, e, o). They can be marked for high pitch (á, é, ó) or be voiceless (whispered), as in à, ò, è. The preferred symbol to indicate voiceless vowels is a dot over the vowels; this symbol is available in Cheyenne fonts for personal use.
