IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – BOTH DAYS

1. **TO ENSURE ACCEPTANCE**, all entries must be in possession of the Trial Secretary by no later than 6:00 PM (PST), WED. February 11, 2009 (except as noted in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, March 9, 1999). After the closing date, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted. The Club is not responsible for incorrect entries.
2. **MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO DVGSDC**. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries.
3. **ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, "in season," excused by the Veterinarian or judge, barred by Show Committee, or incorrectly entered. However, **BITCHES ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE**, if "in season" on the day of the show, will be refunded entry fees less \$2. A veterinarian certification and written request are required.
4. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING**. The club is not obligated to notify exhibitors of the start of judging. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring.
5. **THE CLUB IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR** the loss or damage to any dogs entered whether by accident or other cause. Dogs are in the custody of their owner or agent.
6. **DOGS NEED ONLY** be present at the scheduled time of judging and will be excused when no longer needed for further judging. **DO NOT LEAVE DOGS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES**.
7. **THE AKC RULE** permitting only dogs entered in the trial on the trial grounds will be strictly enforced.
8. **IN ORDER TO PREVENT** loss of the facility for future events, Diablo Valley GSDC asks that participants adhere to facility rules. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when judged.
9. **IT IS EACH PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY** to clean up after his or her dogs and clean up his or her area after the show. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved Judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
