Law placement expert speaks to Washburn law students

TOPEKA Kan.—On February 22, 2006, Jeff Goodman, manager of the legal division of Spencer Reed Group, spoke to members of legal fraternity Phi Delta Alpha at Washburn University in Topeka, Kan., The speech was originally scheduled only for Phi Delta Alpha chapter members but was opened to the entire Washburn University School of Law.
