The Thomas marriage bond was witnessed by James Fowler and the bondsman was John Womack. Samuel Thomas and Susannah Johns Thomas appear to have lived close to the Fowler and Womack families. James Fowler, who witnessed the Thomas marriage bond, married Catey Johns, who is presumed to be a sister of Susannah Johns, in Person County in July, 1802. The Bondsman for the Fowler/Johns wedding was Henry Johns, also a presumed sibling.
