

How to reach UICT?

University Institute of Chemical Technology (UICT) was previously known as UDCT (University Department of Chemical Technology). It is situated in King Circle area of Matunga, near Matunga(E), a central railways local trains railway station. The nearest landmarks are: Don-Bosco School, Khalsa College and VJTI. You can reach the UICT, from the various railway stations as follows:

1. From Dadar Railway Station:

Come out of the Dadar railway station to the eastern side and take a taxi for UICT, Nathalal Parikh Road (preferably ask for Khalsa College or Don Bosco School). The approximate taxi fare is Rs.20

2. From Chattrapati Shivaji Terminus (CST or VT) Railway Station:

Take a local train of central railways for Matunga railway station and get down at the Matunga (it is immediately after Dadar station). Come out of the station to the eastern side and take a taxi for UICT, Nathalal Parikh Road (preferably ask for Khalsa College or Don Bosco School). The approximate taxi fare is minimum which is Rs.13.

(Taxi fare from CST to UICT could be around Rs.90)

3. From Lokamanya Talk Terminus (LTT), Kurla Railway Station

Come to the Tilak Nagar railway station of Harbour Line, which is at a walkable distance from the LTT and take a local train for Wadala. Come out of the station to the western side and take a taxi for UICT, Nathalal Parikh Road (preferably ask for Khalsa College or Don Bosco School). The approximate taxi fare is minimum which is Rs.13.

(Taxi fare from LTT to UICT could be around Rs.100)

4. From Mumbai Central Railway Station (Western railways)

Take a local train for the Dadar and follow the instructions given in 1.

(Taxi fare from Mumbai Central to UICT could be around Rs.100)
