Pinch Hitting

- To avoid large shift penalty in games we trail by 2 or less or to spare AB's
- Murphy, Inglett v any pitcher
- Crawford v rhp

Pinch Running

- For slow runners, 7th or later, less than 2 outs steal in order.
- Crawford first choice, then Sweeney

Hit and Run

Preferred over straight steal when legal, any eligible hitter, SSN of runner >27 adj.
Runners: Bartlett, Sweeney, Span, Inglett, Phillips, Crawford.
1st & 3rd? Yes, only with Doumit or Inglett at bat

Sacrifice

- With Bartlett or Sweeney, 7th or later, +/- 1 run & runner not on 3rd
- No squeeze play!!

Stealing

- Check hit & run first
- Bartlett, Phillips, Span: 6th or later, SSN >27 adj., any # of outs, score +/- 2 runs
- Sweeney, Inglett: same parameters, 8th or later

Runner Advancement

- Send all runner with a 26 or better chance
- Hold runner with 21 or fewer chances unless Adams tables say otherwise.
- Computer managers: send runner "well around third". Hold other runners rounding 3rd unless runner is challenging a weak (<30) arm.
- Trailing runner, do as you would your own team
- Always try to score from 3rd unless 3B, SS, & 2B have combined rating >19.

Infield with Runner on 3rd

- Deep, except 7th or later:
- 3rd or 2nd & 3rd, <2 outs, +/- 1-run game
- 1st & 3rd, 0 outs, +/- 1-run game
- bases full, 0 outs, tie game

Holding Runners

- Hold ALL runners, unless all 3 apply:
- +/- 6 run game, and
- 8th or later, and
- any # of outs.

Outfield Throws

- Always throw if chances are <33
- Throw for trailing runner if lead runner is not tie or lead run, & trailing chance # <15.
- Computer game: if you try to advance trailing runner with lead runner "well around" 3rd, cut the throw & try for trailing runner.

Defensive Replacements

- If we lead by 1-5 runs, after 7th, the defensive alignment should include:
- Phillips on 2nd, Crawford & Span in OF
- Zimmerman on 3rd
- Zaun catching

Starting Pitching

60% of the starts somewhat resemble last year's staff. After that, things fall off dramatically. Unless an arm can be had in the waiver wire, RA Dickey will vacate his role as closer to make 18 starts as a 1. Manage the starters as you would your own

Bullpen

Dickey is the obvious closer, but limit him to save situations only. He'll be making 1 road start in May (have fun Clay), then enter the rotation full time Sept-Nov. At that time the closer's role will be by committee.

Bell, Hanrahan, Ohman, & Yabu: all have middle inning to setup grades. Use as needed to setup Dickey or stop key rallies as early as the 5th. When Dickey starts, any of the 4 can fill as closer.

Feliciano can act as left killer, or come in early during blowouts.

Gaudin & Chulk (when active), are the early guys.
