- 3. Pinch Hitting Pinch hit when it matters (score close) but keep defense up if we lead. (Note that Dye, Tejada, DeRosa, Giles played for games and should be rested if not starting excepting injury)
- 4. Pinch Runner –for slow when score close 8th on, replace catchers (rarely Howard) when game on line. Barmes (and Podsednik, Matthews if up) are the only steal threats that might be on bench.
- 5. Defensive Substitutes after 7th with lead C8
- 6. Sacrifice; Never with Howard, Glaus, Dye, Swisher, Joyce, Kapler Any player not having a first column "1" on 66 and often those with bad shifts even with a "1" to keep them in game will sac on no out, man on second or 1st and 2nd, pitcher "B" or better, score close, late. Ditto for man on first, steal not recommended (especially if adjusted grade over 18). Squeeze bunt ONLY with runners on 3rd, or 2nd and 3rd, 8th or later, score within 1, fast runner.
- 7. Stealing: (check hit and run first) Barmes, DeRosa Kapler,(Podsednik or Matthews when up) after 8th for tying or go ahead run. Rather few attempts here
- 8. Hit and Run Many batters eligible but few runners, therefore Tejada is the only batter and he goes anytime legal with man on first, or men on first and third with 0 or 2 outs.
- **11.** Intentional Walk: If score not close late, big hitter can walk in front of whimp on 2 out, but don't put tying/winning run on base.
- **12.** Pitch from Stretch: On 2 out, for adjusted SSN of 12 or more; on less than 2 out, with adjusted SSN of 15 or more (or 12 if pitcher grade 20 or more).
- 13. Hold runner: For 1B2 never! All others always on none or 1 out; also on 2 out unless runner won't steal.
- 14. Infield deep before 6th, on 2 out, if score difference 3 or more, if man on 1st too. Otherwise play in.
- 15. Offensive runner advancement: By Adams tables. **For computer game**, when obvious (runner well around bag, or on single to right, especially with runners on 1st and 2nd). Consider runner's speed.

- 16. Outfield throws: Never if runner has 33/36 or better chance of safe advance (unless this scores winning run), cutoff automatic, trailing runners hold. Otherwise throw.
- 17. Injuries: Your judgment but see next page. Note that DeRosa can be switched to many positions. Call: (978)-687-2124 for lineup if needed. I trust your judgment.
- 18. Send runner on 3rd: On 2 out, your infield deep, or your defense below average (sum of 2nd + SS + 3rd basemen less than 19).
- 19. Defense against multiple steals: Pitch from stretch as appropriate. Hold ball and free steal of 2nd (no steal of home) for men on 1st and 3rd (unless #12 applies); for runners on 1st and 2nd go for lowest SSN.

Check who is active, Albers, Carrasco, League, Cormier not active every month (Meredith takes season off)

Closer: Howell or Geary 8th or 9th (LHP or RHP as needed)

Set-up: Papelbon, Jenks, Lopez, League 7th or 8th (use as needed, not in this order)

Middle: any set-up plus Albers 6th or 7th

Long; Carassco, Albers, (Cormier, if up, especially for de la Rosa)

MOP – low grade (there may be nothing less than 15* yes, we are that good)

Duchscherer tries for seven, Albers, Wakefield, Hernandez try to get into seventh, Moyer and de la Rosa might leave early if in trouble. If we are leading after 5th, the only starter who should be in a position to lose would be Duchscherer. We have over 460 innings 13* up and another 140 innings just in case we run short so use the bullpen! The following chart may be altered by usage so please look for email with roster changes.

GOTHAM CITY PHILOSPHY THIS YEAR

We should reach the playoffs as a good (but not great) team in a weak conference. Division rivals strongest competition. Bullpen is team strength - use it - starter (except Duchscherer) should not lose lead after 6th. We have extra reliever on months when de la Rosa starts - Carasco is his caddy and can come in early if he falters. Speed is team weakness - few steal attempts but if game goes into extra innings we'll use them then.

In Case of Injury, use this table - keep defense up.

C - Barajas and Navarro and they can substitute for each other.

1b - Swisher, Baker

2b - Mostly De Rosa, some Barmes vs LHP

SS - Mostly Tajeda but some Barmes

3b - Glaus vs RHP, DeRosa LHP.

CF - Giles, Swisher, Kapler (and Podsednik Matthews Venable) qualified

RF - Dye (may be some Podsednik or Venable)

LF - Joyce (RHP), Kapler (LHP)

Dh - Howard all 162 games
