Minors April Hitters

Callaspo (will be up to play for Matsui starting in August), Treanor, Lahair, Chavez (up in May to August)

Bench

For the most part this season we will go with a four man bench. If a player is in the standard column and he is on the bench then he will not come off the bench i.e.

Mientkiewicz.

Baldelli. His role is a RH pinch hitter for all the sorry LH bats on this club. He can play the OF for injured players.

Ojeda is back up for 3B and defensive replacement the late in the game. Also back up at 2B and SS.

Moeller is back up catcher. Will play defense if in the 9th base runners with 20+ attempts due up in the first 4 batters and it matters to keep runners close.

Bourn think Charlie Finlay and Herb Washington. Runs for the slow 6 speed guys. Has a green light if no HR chance. Will play defense for Lewis.

OFFENSE

Hit and Run With Runners and any 2 HR hitter. Matsui, Bourn, Ramirez, and Lewis until 2 SBA per series and then with Chavez or Gordon for 1 SBA

Steal see HR first but use steal in 7th or later Ramirez, Bourn and Matsui and they are n important run.

Bourn to pinch run for any slow runner in the 8th or later if it is the tying, winning or insurance run

Baldelli can PH against LHP 3 or less behind in the 7th or later, for Mein in 8th. Baldelli to OF and Teahan to 1B. Also for Gordon with Ojeda to 3rd, and Chavez and play the OF.

Bunt with Bourn, Ojeda, Moeller, up with non out and a non slow runner.

Runners advance with 22 plus chances or well around.

DEFENSE

Infield deep till the 7th then in if tying or next to tying run at third.

Hold runners as per default

In the eighth or ninth Ojeda to 3B, Bourn in for Lewis,

In the 9th base runners with 20+ attempts due up in the first 4 batters and it matters to keep runners close bring in Moeller.

Always keep DP in order unless chance for winning or tying run. Cut throws if lead runner is not scoring winning or tying run.

PITCHING

Starters need to pitch till fatigued for the most part especially when trailing. Keep starter in if pitching a shutout. Pull when fatigued or within 3 batters of fatigue and runners on base.

Relief

Most months there will be seven relievers this season. We have four sets of relievers and some general instructions. I will let you decide how to use them specifically, but I look for mixing and matching but generally no more than using three relievers per game.

Johnson, Broxton and Gregg

This is the main part of the bullpen. There are 204 innings here. Broxton and Johnson are the main closers. Gregg owns a W so be cautious and do not use him with men on base. This group moves through the part of the 8th and 9th.

Marshall, Miner Acosta and Foulke

Use caution not to use Marshall and Miner from the bullpen when they are a starter for the month. Marshall is the main LHP for the 1 or 2 outs depending on how many LH batters are bunched in the line up. Foulke to prevent HR or need a strikeout Use him any time after the 6th. Acosta would be the 7th inning guy with Miner in the 6th 7th inning slot. Between these three there is 154 innings.

Aardsma, Yates, Rusch, Corpas and Campillo

These guys are pretty much first out of the bullpen. Rusch is the early LHP for special match ups. Yates and Campillo when leading, they have 94 IP. Corpas, Rusch Aardsma to try and keep it close have 165 IP.

Special needs boys Correia and Ohlendorf are innocuous and hopefully won't be needed
