Unless, and until, it is determined that a patient is able to pay for all or a portion of his care, the various pieces of information necessary to crate an itemized statement of costs are not gathered together. Only when it is determined that a patient is able to pay a share of the cost of his care is this information assembled and organized into a billing statement. Until that time, no statement of charges is prepared or available.
