AFFIDAVIT JOURNAL ENTRY

Monday, May 2, 2005

I received back unsealed not only the large envelope I sent sealed to Warden Adams as confidential mail on 4/10/05 (with the memo dated 4/7/05), but also the six unlawfully obstructed envelopes contained therein of outgoing confidential (/legal) mail I submitted into the prison's mail system on 4/3/05 to: 1) Justice Blease of the Calif. 3rd Dist. Court of Appeal; 2) the presiding judge of the Amador County Superior Court of Calif.; 3) the warden & appeals coordinator of the Calif. State Prison in L.A. County; 4) the Amador County Superior Court of Calif.; 5) Deputy Attorney General K.L. Pollard; and 6) the L.A. County Superior Court of California. Enclosed in the large envelope with the 6 obstructed envelopes I found a memo from Mailroom Sergeant C. Pugliese which falsely states: "Each article of mail that requires the mailroom to apply postage will require it's [sic] own CDC Form 193 attached to the envelope." In addition, the outside of the large envelope addressed to the warden has been falsely stamped three times with the words "NON-CONFIDENTIAL PER CALIF. ADMIN. CODE 3141-3143." It appears that Pugliese or some other mailroom staff unlawfully opened the large envelope addressed to the warden to prevent it and its contents from reaching the warden. I am going to again borrow stamps in violation of CCR15 § 3010 to mail the envelope to the CSP-LAC warden & appeals coordinator, fill out separate CDC forms 193 for each of the 6 obstructed envelopes even though I am not "required" to do so, put all 6 envelopes back into the mailbox to prevent further delay in their leaving the prison, prepare a staff complaint against Pugliese for opening the large envelope addressed to the warden, and add this issue to the grievance I submitted on 4/10/05 concerning mail obstruction at this prison.

I, Eric Charles Rodney K'Napp, swear under penalty of perjury that this affidavit entry is true and was made within just hours of the event(s) chronicled herein.
