<p>Transformational leadership occurs when leaders broaden and elevate the interests of their followers, when they generate awareness and acceptance of the purposes and mission of the group, and when they stir their followers to look beyond their own self-interest for the good of the group.</p> <p>Transformational leadership is the most comprehensive theory of leadership and is supported by a large body of empirical research.</p> <p>Most of us can recall an individual in our lives who inspired us to reach our fullest potential. However, we are often limited in our efforts to inspire others and we have to rely on extrinsic punishments and rewards to guide their behavior.
