

Ice Cream Bars (Revels)

Supplies:

Flat Toothpicks
Exacto Knife
Model Magic©
Chocolate Brown Acrylic Paint
Cocoa Gallery Glass
Tacky Glue
3/16" Kemper Cutter

Instructions:

Cut your toothpicks in half using your exacto knife until you get slivers that would resemble the Stick of the bars about 5/16" long.

Now form a length of Model Magic © about 1/4" wide. Cut these into 5/16" sections and round the top slightly. Dip your stick into glue and then insert into the Model Magic Bars. Set aside to dry overnight.

Squeeze some brown paint into a container and add 2 drops of paint to 1/4tsp of Cocoa Gallery Glass. Take, the now dry, bars and dip into the paint mixture. Be sure to dip it far enough into the paint that you get a little on the stick. Place the Ice Cream bar into some floral foam to dry.

To have a bar with a bite taken from it using the 3/16" circle Kemper Cutter remove a corner prior to sealing it.
