

Terri's Fruit Danish

Supplies:

Champagne Fimo
Sapphire Gallery Glass
Ruby Red Gallery Glass
Sunny Yellow Gallery Glass
Blue or Black Hole-less beads (blueberries)
Red Painted Mustard Seeds (cherries)
Pastel Chalk (Rusty coloured)
Matte Finish Sealer



Directions:

Take a small amount of the Fimo (1/4" ball" approximately) and roll out snakes approx. 1/16" thick. Press lightly on each of the snakes to lightly flatten tops and bottom. Place your index finger on either end of the fimo snake and then pull your left finger toward yourself and the right one rolling away. This should give your fimo a Twisted look, twist until you get the look you desire.

Next you will begin to shape the twisted snake into rounds. Start with one end of the twisted snake (for the center) and wrap around and around until you get the size you like (approx. 1/4" or just a tad bigger) press your finished end into the round. Lightly dust the danish with the chalk and bake according to package instructions about 5 minutes

Once done let the Danishes cool before moving onto decorating.

For the Lemon Danish add a thin layer of the Sunny Gallery Glass to the center working your way outward until you have the desired filling. You may have to add 2 more thin layers of the Sunny Gallery Glass but be sure to let them dry between layers.

For the Blueberry Danish, place your blueberries (beads or painted brown mustard seeds) and cover with the Sapphire Gallery Glass. You may need to add a second coat of the Gallery Glass.

For Cherry Danish, place your cherries (painted yellow mustard seeds) in the center of your danish and cover with Ruby Red Gallery Glass. You may need to add a second coat of the Gallery Glass.

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
