A Scenario for Hit the Deck!

Introduction

The Dniesti Bridge is a fictional scenario for up to 12 players for the **Hit the Deck!** skirmish rules published by OCULUS.

The scenario is set on the Ukrainian Front near Kamenets Podolsky at the end of March 1944. The Russian 8th and 47th Armies have been advancing on all fronts since 2nd February. The speed of the most recent advance threatens to cut off Army Group South including the 1st and 2nd SS Panzer Divisions which are attempting to withdraw over the Dniesti river. German control of the bridges over the Dniesti will allow them to withdraw and hold the Russian advance. Russian control of the bridges will cut off the German escape route and secure an opportunity to continue the advance.

Umpire Notes

The various units have differing victory conditions in order to add a little interest. Players should be encouraged to role play their parts and take heed of their specific victory conditions. Type cast the "parts" to suit the players' styles. Variables may be pre-determined (e.g. whether the explosives the Engineers bring with them will blow the bridge) or can be determined by the Umpire at the relevant time for maximum dramatic value.

If less than 12 players are to be involved either remove parts or place them under Umpire control.

Bridge Security Detail Briefing

You are Lieutenant (Lt.) Braun in command of the Bridge Security detail. Your orders are to keep the bridge open and clear for military traffic. You will be extremely reluctant to relinquish command without direct orders from your immediate superiors, you have no radio and the telephone lines are down. You have an extreme hatred for the SS and will not surrender command to any SS unit in any event. Rumours have been circulating about Russian spies in German uniforms infiltrating the German lines in order to commit sabotage. You have been ordered to keep on the alert for such activities and must scrutinise all papers prior to accepting any German Officer or soldier at face value.

Victory Conditions

Keeping the bridge open and under Army control unless orders received to the contrary.

Steiner (from a previous command) knows the truth and you fear him greatly as he is a hardened veteran. Your current command is an engineering detail who are to destroy the bridge to halt the Russian advance. Any delay will be punished severely. Unfortunately, due to a shortage of supplies, you have only been given civilian explosives and the engineers doubt that these will be man enough for the job.

It will take at least 3 turns to wire the bridge.

Victory Conditions

Destroy the bridge and withdraw as quickly as possible.

Supply Depot Detail Briefing

Friedmann, and are very clear, the supplies in your care are to be retained for the next offensive and should not be surrendered under any circumstances. These orders may only be countermanded by an officer with a rank exceeding that of the officer who issued them. Your supplies include ammunition for all calibres of small arms in current issue to the Army, two boxes of 24 hand grenades, three Panzerfausts and some military issue explosives.

Victory Conditions

Maintain all supplies intact and unused.

In addition, you have been ordered to find and commandeer stores and/or equipment as your supplies are running low. You must secure the bridge, report back to Divisional command and hold it against all comers until reinforcement arrives. As the part of Leibstandarte Adolf Hitler, originally formed as the Fuhrer's personal bodyguard, you consider yourselves superior to all others including other SS units.

Victory Conditions

Keep the bridge open and in SS control to allow the 1st SS Panzer Division to withdraw.

Keep the bridge open and in SS control to allow the 2nd SS Panzer Division to withdraw.
