Saturday Soccer School: The Soccer School is up and running and getting good numbers. In winter it takes place on the astro-turf in good weather and indoors when the weather is bad. It is on from 10am–12pm every Saturday morning. If your child is not picked to play in the games, we strongly advise your child to attend this training session. The costs are the same (£2.00) and a coach is there to take the session. This is open to **all** age groups. This will enhance your child's fitness, skills and attributes in footballing skills.

Kids born 1999/ 2000: The club is looking to attract players of this age group. The training will initially take place at the Soccer School on a Saturday and when we have coaches in place, then the individual age group will have their own training night and time. If you have a child in this age group, then please come forward and get involved in coaching.

Coaches/ Parent Helpers: The club are always looking for help. If you would like to help out as a coach or a parent helper, the club would appreciate this. Most teams would appreciate new coaches and/ or someone to collect money from the kids and general admin duties. If you fancy becoming involved, we need to satisfy the SYFA and Disclosure Scotland where you will be asked to complete a Disclosure form as this involves working with children. If you would like to become a coach, the club will pay for you to attend and get your coaching badges. If you require any more information, please contact your coach or a committee member. All coaches, committee and parent helpers involved at the club, are parents like you.

Home Games/Training: When dropping your child off for training or games can you please liaise with your coach before leaving your child to make sure that matches and training is going ahead. In the past we have had instances of matches/training being called off and no way of contacting the parents to have there children collected leaving the child hanging about in the cold for two hours. Please also make sure your child arrives suitably dressed for the weather conditions. The kids must have shin pads and water including any money for the session.

Matches: Each team needs help to set up and dismantle the goals. If you are there to watch the match it would be very much appreciated if you could help with this as this frees the coaches to change/ warm up the team.

S.F.A. Quality Mark: It was decided at the last Coaches meeting that Rothes Juniors FC would be working towards the next level of Quality Mark.
